

Huron School District COVID-19 Guidance 2022-2023

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Wayne County Health Department (WCHD), have created the below guidance for those with or exposed to COVID-19.

POSITIVE CASES: Students and staff who test positive for COVID-19 and/or display COVID-19 symptoms should isolate regardless of vaccination status:

- Isolate at home for 5 days (the day symptoms begin or day test was taken for students and staff who do not have symptoms); and
- Return on Day 6* Students and staff may return to school if symptom-free, while wearing a well-fitted mask, for days 6 -10; or
- Stay home for 10 days until symptoms have mostly resolved.

*If you have a fever, stay home until you are fever free for a period of 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.

CLOSE CONTACT AT SCHOOL: Wayne County has adopted the self-quarantine and isolation guidance from MDHHS for schools. Additionally, if the COVID exposure occurred in the school setting, no contact tracing is required. This includes in-school contacts, classrooms, buses, lunch and extra-curricular activities.

SYMPTOM MONITORING RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Watch for symptoms, such as fever, cough, shortness of breath or other COVID-19 symptoms.
- If symptoms develop, get tested immediately and isolate until receiving test results. If the test is positive, follow isolation guidance and contact your school office immediately.
